

Pupil B is a student in Year 11 of Abbey Hill school. He hopes to attend the further education department next year, with big aspirations of becoming a bus driver. Despite living around 15 miles away from school he was eager to gain more independence and make the journey to school without relying on the school transport provided by the local authority. He was very knowledgeable about bus timetables and services but needed some assistance with road safety. Pupil B participated in numerous travel training trips to local town centres, points of interest and to and from his home address and practised crossing the different types of road safely whilst generally keeping himself safe. His parents also supported him in his travel training by encouraging him to make bus journeys outside of school, where they would meet him at either end of the journey if required. Pupil B has now completed his travel training and has a great understanding of personal safety, pedestrian safety and road safety skills. He regularly makes journeys on different bus services across the city to visit friends and family without relying on his parents.
