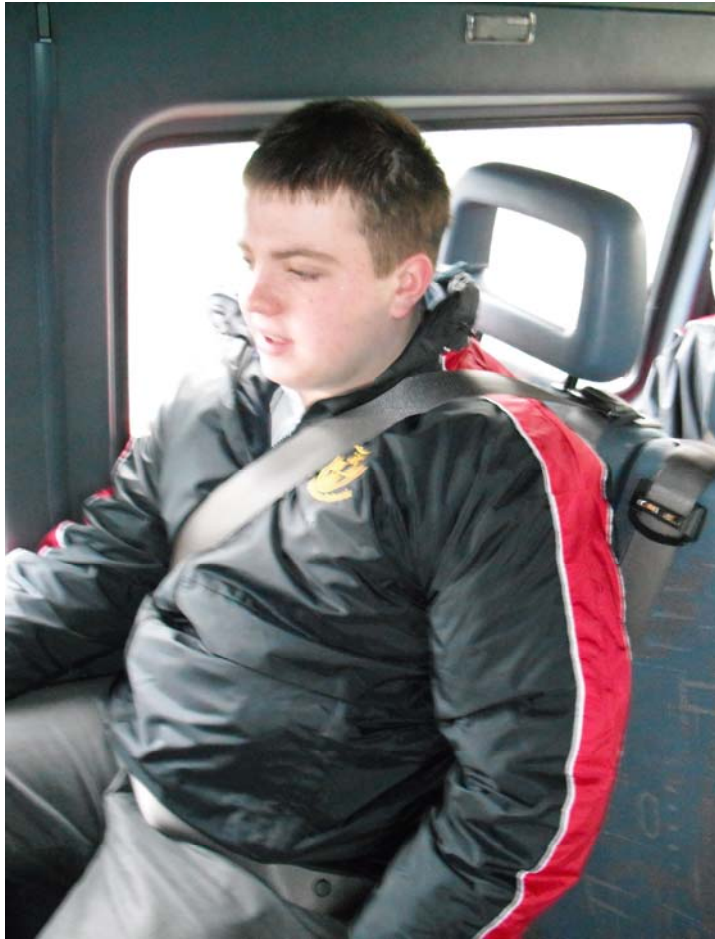


Catching the minibus
